SECTION 50: STUDENT PUBLICATIONS

Approved: April 19, 2004

The College recognizes that student publications, including podcasts, flyers, and social media posts are a valuable aid in establishing and maintaining an atmosphere of free and responsible discussion and intellectual exploration. Student publications serve as a means of bringing student concerns, opinions, and ideas to the attention of the College community and the public.

As citizens, students enjoy the same basic rights and are bound by the same responsibilities as all citizens. Among these rights are freedom of speech and freedom of press. The Board, faculty and staff shall not exercise editorial control over student publications, except where specifically provided by FVCC policies and procedures. The College shall not be deemed to endorse the content of these publications unless so stated.
